

What am I allowed to bring to the workshop?

- You can bring ONE small piece of furniture such as an end table, coffee table, chair, nightstand, twin headboard. Please send photo of your piece with dimensions prior to class for approval to info@sohogreenville.com. There will be an upcharge if someone shows up with a larger piece.
- You must be able to carry it in by yourself, no dressers or medium/large pieces of furniture.
- The goal is to finish it in the three to four hour time period!
- Please inspect your piece prior to class: We'll jump right into painting, so please make sure your furniture is in good repair, remove drawer pulls and hardware, bring them along to paint if you'd like. Make sure any loose veneer is glued, drawers are fixed, legs are tightened and piece is cleaned prior to class.
- Please remove any pieces of loose poly, flaking paint and do any type of sanding you want done prior to class. We will be starting in on painting right away and don't want anyone kicking up dust.
- It's also very important to clean your piece with a good de-greaser prior to class. You can use our American Paint Company Surface Prep and Brush Cleaner or something like Simple Green or White Vinegar if you have that on hand at home. Make sure to wipe the entire piece down before coming to class...we only have 3 to 4 hours to get this done and don't want to waste time on prep work.
